Our goal is to provide the highest level of coordinated care while you are here at Kennedy Krieger. With the multidisciplinary Sturge-Weber Clinic, our patients can see 4 providers (or more) from 8:30am-12:00pm on the 1st Friday of each month.

Our Team

- **Dr. Comi** (Director) Medical and neurological evaluation to diagnose patient, develop treatment plan, and coordinate evaluations
- Dr. Zabel (Neuropsychology) Evaluate the patient for learning, mood, and other behavioral disabilities
- Dr. Suskauer (Medical rehabilitation, physiatry) – Evaluate the patient's function and make recommendations to improve function such as with bracing, equipment, or therapies
- Teressa Reidy (Occupational therapy) –
 Improve patients' fine motor skills for use in daily living activities (eating, dressing, hygiene, toileting and play activities), oral motor skills and adaptive seating needs
- Tracy Schneider (physical therapy) assess and treat disorders that limit an individual's movement, functional mobility, and ability to participate in daily activities
